

NOTICE OF A CLASS ACTION
AUTHORIZED BY THE SUPERIOR COURT OF QUÉBEC

Did you purchase a parking heater for commercial vehicle or did you purchase, lease or sublease a vehicle equipped with such parking heater?

If so, you might be a member of this class action

- On March 17, 2015, Transport TFI 6, S.E.C. ("**TFI 6**") filed a class action against Webasto and Espar (more precisely, Webasto SE, Webasto Thermo & Comfort SE, Webasto Thermo & Comfort North America, Inc., Espar Inc., Espar Climate Control Systems, Eberspaecher Climate Control Systems International Beteiligungs-GmbH, Eberspaecher Climate Control Systems GmbH & Co. KG, Eberspaecher Gruppe GmbH & Co. KG and Espar Products Inc.) (the "**Defendants**"), manufacturers and sellers of parking heaters for commercial vehicles ("**Parking heaters**"). TFI 6 alleges that these manufacturers and sellers have formed a cartel and conspired to restrict competition and to unreasonably raise the price of Parking heaters and vehicles in which they are installed.
- On December 20, 2017, the Superior Court authorized TFI 6 to file a class action against the Defendants.
- **This judgment may affect your rights, whether you act or not. Please read this notice carefully.**

YOUR RIGHTS IN THIS CLASS ACTION	
EXCLUDE YOURSELF ("OPT OUT")	If you exclude yourself ("Opt Out"), you will not receive any payment if a settlement is reached between the parties or if the Court grants a final decision in favor of TFI 6. This option allows you to continue your own lawsuit against the Defendants for the portion of the price you have overpaid because of the cartel.
DO NOTHING	If you are a class member and you agree with the purpose of this class action against the Defendants, you have nothing to do to participate in this class action.

- These rights – **and the deadline for exercising them** – are explained in this notice.

BASIC INFORMATION

1. WHY ARE YOU RECEIVING THIS NOTICE?

On December 20, 2017, the Superior Court authorized TFI 6 to file a class action against the Defendants. This notice explains how the class action works, who the class members are and what their rights are.

2. WHAT IS THIS CLASS ACTION ABOUT?

TFI 6 instituted a class action against the Defendants who manufacture and sell Parking heaters. TFI 6 alleges that the Defendants have formed a cartel and conspired to restrict competition and to unreasonably raise the price of Parking heaters and vehicles in which they are installed. The Defendant Espar Inc. pleaded guilty in the United States to cartel-related charges. The Defendants Eberspaecher Gruppe GmbH & Co. KG and Eberspaecher Climate Control Systems GmbH & Co. KG have been fined 68,175 million euros by the European Commission for coordinating the sale price of Parking heaters and for dividing customers, together with the Defendants Webasto SE and Webasto Thermo & Comfort SE, throughout the European Economic Area.

Parking heaters are installed inside commercial vehicles and are used to heat the cabin. They operate independently of the engine operation of the commercial vehicles in which they are installed.

Parking heaters are used in various types of commercial vehicles, such as tractors semi-trailers, vans for transportation of goods, buses, agricultural vehicles, dump trucks and ambulances.

The class action seeks in particular to reimburse class members for the portion of the price they have overpaid for Parking heaters or vehicles because of the cartel.

3. WHY IS IT A CLASS ACTION?

In a class action, an individual called the "Class Representative" institutes a lawsuit, on behalf of everyone who has the same problem, called the "class." TFI 6 represents all members of the class. A class action allows the Court to resolve the issue in dispute for all class members, except for those who choose to exclude themselves.

CLASS MEMBERS

4. WHO IS A CLASS MEMBER?

You are a class member if, between September 13, 2001 and December 31, 2012:

- a) You purchased in Québec one or more Parking heaters.

OR

- b) You purchased, leased or subleased, in Québec, one or more vehicles equipped with one or more Parking heaters.

5. HOW DO I PARTICIPATE IN THIS CLASS ACTION?

If you are a class member and agree with the purpose of this class action, you have nothing to do to participate in this class action.

6. CAN I INTERVENE IN THIS CLASS ACTION?

Yes. If you are a class member and you request it, the Court may allow you to intervene in the court proceedings if your intervention is deemed useful to the class. An intervention is useful if, for example, it aims to support TFI 6's claims or allegations. If you intervene, you may be subject to an examination by the Defendants and you may have to pay judicial fees.

EXCLUDE YOURSELF / OPTING OUT

If, for any reason, you do not wish to be bound by this class action, you must take steps to exclude yourself from the class. This could be the case if you think you can obtain more money by suing the Defendants yourself, or for any other reason.

7. WHAT HAPPENS IF I OPT OUT?

If you opt out:

- 1) You retain the right to institute your own lawsuit against the Defendants for the cartel;
- 2) You will not be entitled to receive a payment if a settlement is reached between the parties or if the Court grants a final decision in favor of TFI 6.
- 3) You will not be bound by any judgment rendered by the Court in this class action.

8. WHAT HAPPENS IF I DO NOT OPT OUT?

If you do not opt out:

- 1) You give up the right to institute your own lawsuit against the Defendants for the wrongs alleged in this class action;
- 2) You will be entitled to receive a payment if a settlement is reached between the parties or if the Court grants a final decision in favor of TFI 6;
- 3) You will be bound by any judgment rendered by the Court in this action.

9. HOW DO I OPT OUT?

To opt out, you must send a letter to the clerk of the Superior Court of Québec. This letter must include the following information:

- The class action file number: 500-06-000736-153;
- Your name, current address and telephone number;
- Your statement: "I am a class member and I wish to opt out of the class action.";
- Your signature.

If TFI 6 wins the class action against the Defendants, or if a settlement is reached between the parties, TFI 6' lawyers will request payment of their fees and the reimbursement of their costs. These legal fees and costs are generally paid from the amounts received from the Defendants for the class members, provided these fees and costs are approved by the Court.
